



## How do I enable library links in Google Scholar


Did you know that you can obtain full text articles, for any journal that the library has subscribed to, through Google Scholar?

**You will need an NHS OpenAthens ID to access full text articles.**

Go to Google Scholar

Click on the **3 lines**,  
then click on **Settings**.

From that page click on  
**Library Links**.

Online access to library subscriptions is usually restricted to patrons of that library. You may need to login with your library password, use a campus computer, or configure your browser to use a library proxy. Please visit your library's website or ask a local librarian for assistance.

To retain settings, you must turn on cookies

Search for your **NHS OpenAthens** organisation, then place a tick when you have found the correct one and click **Save**.

You will need to have **Cookies** enabled for these settings to save for future visits. Please click the link under **Save** for instructions on how to do this. Alternatively you can create a Google account and this should also save your settings.

When you next perform a search in Google Scholar, if you see **STHK NHS Library** at the side of your results, this means that you will have full text access to the article.

Click on the **STHK NHS Library** link.
